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Barcelona

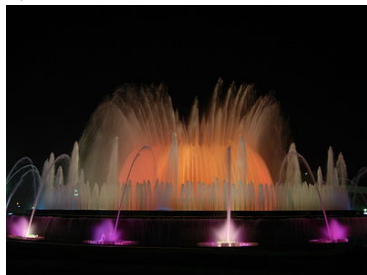
10th, 11th and 12th June 2010

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Thursday 10:

- 19:00h: Arrival at the hotel (yet to be confirmed) and check-in.
- 20:00h: Tourist tour on our “boats” through *Montjuïc*, where we will see the *Castle*, the *Olympic Stadium*, the *Telecom. Tower by Calatrava*, or the *Palau Sant Jordi Sports Centre*, among other places of interest.
- 21:00h: Light, music and colour show at the *Montjuïc Fountain* in Montjuïc.



Duration: 20 minutes Price: Free.

- 21:30h: Dinner in a restaurant of the area (yet to be confirmed)
- 23:30h: Night tour through some of the most important landmarks of the city, and then back to the hotel to sleep...

Friday 11:

- 08:00h: Breakfast
- 08:30h: Public transport to *Catalunya* (town centre). From there, walking tour through Barcelona's old town (the Gothic Quarter).
- 10:00h: Guided visit to the *Palau de la Música Catalana* (the Catalan Music Concert Hall), designed by the architect *Lluís Domènech i Montaner*.

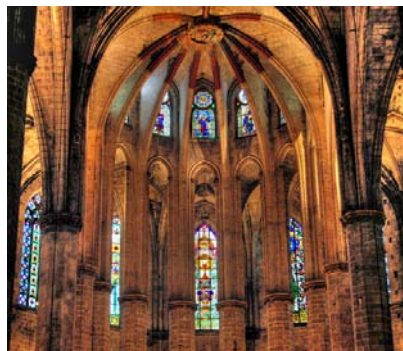


Duration: 50 minutes Price: 12€/pers.

- 11:00h: Walking tour through some interesting places of the Old Town such as *Santa Caterina* Market, the *Cathedral* and *Sant Jaume* square, where we will see the *Ajuntament de Barcelona* (the city's town hall) and the *Palau de la Generalitat de Catalunya* (seat of the Catalan government).



From there, we will head for *Santa Maria del Mar*, one of the most beloved Gothic churches in the city.



-12:00h: Visit to the *Museu d'Història de Catalunya* (the museum of Catalan History), so that we can learn a bit of Catalan history and culture, from Prehistory to the present day.



Duration: 1 hour 30 minutes Price: 4€pers.

-13:45h: Lunch in a restaurant of the area (yet to be confirmed).

-15:45h: Trip on board the *Bus Turístic* (Tourist Bus) from *Plaça Palau* to *Passeig de Gràcia*, so that we can take some pictures of *Casa Batlló* (Batlló House), by *Antoni Gaudí*, and visit (on a guided tour) *La Pedrera* or *Casa Milà*, another of this genius' works...



Duration: 1 hour 30 minutes Price: 14€pers.

-17:15h: Back on the *Bus Turístic*, we will then go to see the –perhaps- most representative symbol of Barcelona and Gaudí in the world: the majestic temple of *La Sagrada Família*...



Duration: 1 hour Price: 14€pers.

- 18:30h: To finish the visit to the long list of Gaudi´s works, we will visit the impressive **Parc Güell**, where, apart from being able to admire its unique architecture, we will enjoy a great panoramic view over the town centre and surroundings...



Duration: 2 hours Price: Free access

- 21:00h: “**Tapas**” dinner at **Casa Pepe**, restaurant located in Santa Coloma de Gramenet (approx. price 20/30€/per person)
-23:30h: After a tiring yet enjoyable tourist day, back to the hotel to have a little rest...

Saturday 12:

- 09:00h: Breakfast
-09:30h: Departure, now on our own “**boats**” at last, to visit the **Museo-Monestir de Pedralbes** (Monastery-Museum) a beautiful example of a **Catalan Gothic Art**...



Duration: 50 minutes Price: 6€/pers.

-11:00h: Optionally*, there is the possibility of visiting (on a guided tour) the most visited museum in *Catalonia* and the third in *Spain*, the “*Museu del Futbol Club Barcelona*” (FC Barcelona Museum and Stadium)...



Duration: 1 hour Price: 17€pers.

*If most of the members agree or are interested in doing so.

-12:00h: We start a trip of approx.75 kms , along the *Costas del Garraf* (Garraf Coast), and thus enjoy a beautiful winding road of great scenery and views over the sea that will lead us to the *Pantà de Foix* reservoir, until we reach the mediaeval hamlet of *Castellet*.



There we will be able to visit the *Castle*, from which we will be able to take some beautiful pictures of the reservoir and the surrounding landscape...



Duration: 2 hours Price: Free

-14:00h: Lunch in a restaurant of the area (still to be confirmed)

-16:30h: Return to Barcelona through the *Ordal* Mountain Pass, *Molins de Rei*, *Vallvidrera*, until we reach Mount *Tibidabo*, the highest in the *Collserola* mountain range, and also the highest point in Barcelona, 525m above sea level.



There, we will visit the *Sagrat Cor* church, and we will have the chance to enjoy some superb views of the city, the sea and the surroundings.



Duration: 2 hours 30 minutes

-19:45h: As a perfect finale to the *Meeting*, we will have dinner at the *Restaurant-Masia Can Janer*, located in the natural area of *Collserola*, Barcelona's true "green lung", and to which we will arrive driving up the mythical *Rabassada* road, one of the stages of the 2009 *Tour de France*.
At *Can Janer* we will have the chance to do some Catalan cuisine tasting: *salads*, "*escalivada*", *grilled vegetables*, "*botifarra amb mongetes*", etc...
Price: approx. 25/30€/per person.

-22:30h: Descent through *La Rabassada* road, heading for the hotel.
Present-giving to all the participants.
End of the *Meeting*.

***Hotel prices range between 65 and 80€**

Restaurant prices range between 20€and 35€

The prices for the cultural visits are per person. Group rates can be applied, however, if the necessary minimum number of people for each visit is reached.

All the prices will be confirmed, and the places reserved, once the final number of participants is confirmed.

Collaboration with some enterprises and organizations is currently being dealt with. Final agreements will be published on the final programme.
